General Accountabilities

The Technician, Milling position works within the Cigi technical division and reports to the Manager, Milling Technology. The Technician, Milling is responsible for the operation and maintenance of all equipment and machinery and handling, shipping, receiving and storage of products for the wheat and pulse processing facilities.

Specific Accountabilities

1. Prepares, performs and/or assists in all milling (pilot and laboratory) operations required for practical demonstrations, tours, customer support and research projects.
2. Performs preventative and scheduled maintenance on equipment in milling and pulse processing areas. Updates maintenance records when each machine is serviced.
3. Assists and participates in special projects such as developing new processing techniques for specific projects and field crops.
4. Assists with the installation of equipment in the milling and pulse processing facilities as required.
5. Receives, handles, stores and ships grain, pulses and other milled products in bulk (truck), pallets or large bags (1 ton or greater in weight).
6. Compiles data and maintains an inventory of milled products from wheat, pulses and special crops.
7. Assist with milling responsibilities on fee-for-service activities and other research projects/activities.
8. Performs and demonstrates to participants milling production quality control using objective methods such as digital imaging technology for optimizing flour and semolina refinement and yields.
9. Actively contributes and participates in data monitoring and sample tracking system.
10. Prepares and/or updates milling schedule for all activities in the mill and pulse processing areas.
11. Coordinates maintenance of equipment in other technical areas including annual maintenance.
12. Assists with other duties in the event that other milling staff are away.
13. Provides general housekeeping for milling and pulse processing areas.
14. Bags products and by-products produced during pilot milling weighing up to 40 kgs.

Our Requirements

The ideal candidate is a dynamic, self-starting, innovative individual who has a minimum of 2 years' experience working in a food processing industry and has received equipment operation and maintenance training. Commercial milling experience would be an advantage.

This individual will be self-motivated and have demonstrated the ability to work both independently and co-operatively in a team environment and to develop and maintain effective working relationships with internal and external customers. Good communication skills (verbal and written), decision-making, problem solving and planning skills are critical. Ability and willingness to travel domestically and abroad is a must. Knowledge of Cigi and current agricultural issues would be an asset.
